Courses and others:

Sport Marketing - 1st week, 20h lectures and seminars, pre-assignment, group work presentations, 5-6 pages of lecture diaries, 10-12 pages of written assignment (2 or 4 ECTS credits). Concepts and theory of Sport Marketing, Event Management, and Sport Sponsorship.

International Perspectives to Organisation and Management of Sport - 2nd week, 24h of lectures and 5-6 or 15-20 pages of learning diaries (2 or 4 ECTS credits). Sport Management and Organization of Sport from the perspective of various countries and regions.

Winter Sports - held simultaneously with the other two courses. Practical winter sport lessons for all levels. All equipment and facility fees are included. The activities are snow walking, outdoor trips, crosscountry skiing, downhill skiing, snowboarding, ice skating and ice-hockey (1 ECTS credit).

Other activities - Opening evening, sauna get-together, recreational outdoor activities, Finnish Ice-Hockey League match, closing dinner ceremony. In addition to the side activities, there will be a fulltime tutor assisting all students for practical matters.

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
